"I compete because I want to see how far and how fast I can go. Every day I try to realize my maximum potential," said George. "I'm thrilled to be representing Team USA in Rio because, not only do the Paralympic Games offer an opportunity for me to compete at the highest level, but I also hope to motivate others to push themselves beyond their expectations to achieve their full potential too."

George is one of the most accomplished wheelchair athletes in the world, having won six world titles and five Paralympic medals. The 32-year-old competes in T53 races, a Paralympic classification for athletes with full function of the arms, but no lower spinal muscle activity or leg function. At the Athens 2004 Paralympic Games, George participated in seven events, winning bronze medals in the 100m and 400m races. At the Beijing 2008 Paralympic Games he won gold and silver medals in the 100m and 800m respectively, adding another bronze in the 800m at the London Paralympics in 2012.
